this book addresses intertextual connections between lamentations and texts in each division of the hebrew bible along with

texts throughout history sources examined range from the dead sea scrolls to modern shoah literature allowing the volume's impact to reach beyond lamentations to each of the intertexts the chapters address by bringing together scholars with expertise on this diverse array of texts the volume offers a wide range of exegetical insight it also enables the reader to appreciate the varying intertextual approaches currently employed in biblical studies ranging from abstract theory to rigid method by applying these to a focused analysis of lamentations this book will facilitate greater insight on both lamentations and current methodological research

many of the numbers are translations and or reprints of previously published works

contains papers which reflect the breadth and depth of the field of biomedical and health informatics covering topics such as health information systems education standards consumer health and human factors emerging technologies sustainability organizational and economic issues genomics and image and signal processing

sworn enemies explains how the book of ezekiel uses formulaic language from the exodus origin tradition especially yhwh's oath to craft an identity for the judahite exiles this language openly refutes an autochthonous origin tradition preferred by the non exiled judahites while covertly challenging babylonian claims that yhwh was no longer worthy of worship after specifying the layers of meaning in the divine oath the book shows how ezekiel uses these connotations to construct an explicit public transcript that denies and mocks the non exiles appeals to a combined abraham and jacob tradition e.g. ezek 35 simultaneously ezekiel employs the oath's exodus connotations to support a disguised polemic that resists babylonian claims that yhwh was powerless to help the exiles when yhwh swears as i live the text goes on to implicitly replace marduk with yhwh as the deity who controls nations and history e.g. ezek 17 ezekiel thus shares the monotheistic concepts found in deuterio isaiah and elsewhere finally using james c scott's concept of hidden transcripts the author shows how both polemics cooperate to define a legitimate judahite nationalism and faithful yahwism that allows the exiles to resist these threatening others

ingrid hjelm examines the composition of the books of kings using the hezekiah narratives in 2 kings 18 20 as a focus she argues that this narrative is taken from that of the book of isaiah with which it shares linguistic and thematic elements in kings it is used with the specific purpose of breaking the compositional pattern of curse which threatens to place jerusalem on a par with samaria jerusalem traditions are examined against theories of a late yahwist author and the pentateuch's origin within a jerusalem cult while the pentateuch in its final form became a common work acceptable to all groups because of its implied ambiguity the deuteronomistic history's favoring of david and jerusalem holds a rejection of competitive groups as its implied argument
